

## **RESOLUTION REGARDING INCOMING ENROLLMENT OPTION STUDENTS**

Broken Bow Public Schools hereby sets the following guidelines for the transfer of students under the Nebraska Enrollment Option Program for the 2016-2017 school year.

- The deadline date will be waived for both incoming and outgoing enrollment option students
- The superintendent of schools shall have the authority to accept or deny applications in accordance with this resolution
- Other than under extenuating circumstances, to be determined by the building principal, incoming enrollment options students in grades 9-12 may enter only at the beginning of a semester
- A student who is currently serving a suspension or an expulsion in the resident district will not be accepted as an enrollment option student
- Capacity for classes and programs is hereby set at the following levels

**Elementary (grades K-5):**

Incoming option students will not be accepted if the addition of the student would create a class size of larger than 22 (twenty-two) students

**Secondary (grades 6-12):**

Incoming option students will not be accepted if the addition of the student would create any class size of larger than 22 (twenty-two) students

**Choice Program:**

The CHOICE Program (alternative education) is at capacity, and no enrollment option students will be accepted.

**Special Education:**

Life Skills Program is at capacity and no enrollment option students will be accepted.

Behavior Disorder Program is at capacity and no enrollment option students will be accepted.

An enrollment option student whose Individualized Education Plan (IEP) prescribes a program not currently offered by Broken Bow will not be accepted.

An enrollment option student whose enrollment would necessitate the hiring of additional staff will not be accepted.
