

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must successfully complete the courses required by the board and Nebraska Department of Education in order to graduate.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to ensure that students complete grades one through twelve and that high school students complete 240 credits prior to graduation. The following credits will be required:

English or Vocational English	40 credit hours
American Studies I & II	20 credit hours
Science	30 credit hours
Mathematics	30 credit hours
Physical Education/Health	10 credit hours
Computer/Technology Class	5 credit hours
Speech Communications	5 credit hours
Consumer Education	5 credit hours
Junior/Senior Social Studies	20 credit hours
Total Elective Hours	75 credit hours
Total Required Hours for Graduation	240 credit hours

Graduation requirements for special education students will be in accordance with the prescribed course of study as described in their Individualized Education Program (IEP). Each student's IEP will include a statement of the projected date of graduation at least 18 months in advance of the projected date and the criteria to be used in determining whether graduation will occur. Prior to the special education student's graduation, the IEP team shall determine whether the graduation criteria have been met.
