CUSTER COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP

Custer County Farm Bureau will award up to five (5) scholarships in the amount of \$350 (three hundred fifty dollars) or more. These scholarships are intended for educational assistance to students who are majoring in an agricultural-related program, including agri-business.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior or college student exhibiting the desire and ability to continue their education at a post-high school educational institution.
2. Selection will be made by the Custer County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee. All applications must be received no later than March 15, 2011. Selection will be announced no later than the graduation of the recipient.
3. Applicants must be a resident of Custer County or in the Custer County Farm Bureau membership area.
4. Applicants must be majoring in an agricultural or agricultural-related program, including agri-business.
5. Applicants must fill out the entire application.
6. Applicants must include a copy of his/her high school grade transcript.
7. Required to include a photo. (May be used for news release purposes)

SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

1. The scholarship money will be paid directly to the college after proof in enrollment and completion of the first semester. (With proof of passing grades.)
2. Recipients of the scholarship must have demonstrated satisfactory academic performance during the first semester and cannot change to a non-agricultural major in order to receive the money.
3. A copy of the first semester grade report, proof of enrollment/attendance for the second semester from your college, and student's id number should be mailed to:

4. Upon receipt of grades and proof of enrollment/attendance the payment of the scholarship will be sent directly to the college for use towards books, tuition, or school use, during the second semester.
