# Nebraska Junior Chamber United States JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Application

This package contains information and directions for applying to the Nebraska Junior Chamber and the United States JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Programs. Each year the Nebraska Junior Chamber Scholarship Fund will award at least one \$500 scholarship to a child of, member of, or former member of the Nebraska Junior Chamber who plans on continuing their education at an approved post-secondary school.

The recipient of this scholarship will have the opportunity to have their application forwarded on to the United States JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Program. Each year \$1,000 grants will be awarded to graduating high school seniors in the United States, who plan to continue their education at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities or vocational schools. The number of grants awarded annually will be at the discretion of the United States JCI Senate Foundation.

The awards must be used for educational expenses in the first year of full-time study. Checks awarded will be made out in the name of the recipient and the educational institution of their choice.

**Family members involved with the selection of scholarship recipients are not eligible to receive the Nebraska Junior Chamber Scholarship, but the recipient's entry may be forwarded for the US JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship grant if eligible.**

- Supporting documentation of your choice may follow each page as appropriate
- Reference letters are limited to five (5) with a maximum length of one (1) page each.
- Your name must be on the top of each sheet in the package, along with a page numbering system that states "page \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_".
- All materials **MUST** be submitted under one cover. Materials sent in multiple mailings will **NOT** be accepted.
- Deadline for submission postmarked is **December 31**.
