

SENIOR PHOTOGRAPHS

High School Seniors will have the opportunity to submit senior photographs for the high school yearbook. Seniors may have the opportunity to submit photographs for other public recognition ceremonies (for example a video at commencement, at activity recognition banquets, and the like). Seniors wishing to have the school publish these photographs must comply with the following requirements:

1. The student/family must have permission to reproduce the photograph from the original photographer
2. The student must be wearing attire that complies with the school's dress code in the photograph.
3. The student may not be depicted using drugs, alcohol or tobacco.
4. Artifacts
 - a. The student may be depicted with an artifact illustrating the student's accomplishments or interests.
 - b. In general, students will be permitted to submit photographs illustrating an interest in hunting, shooting and other outdoor sporting activities.
 - c. If a student's interest artifact is an item that is ordinarily considered a weapon (rifle, shotgun, knife, etc), the student may not be brandishing the weapon or pointing it at the camera.
 - d. A student's display of an interest artifact must be tasteful and appropriate. For example, a student should not submit a photograph of game shot by the student if the animal is in obvious distress.
