 - 2) Home residence must be in one of the Nebraska counties of Custer, Dawson, Frontier, Hayes, Keith, Lincoln, Logan, McPherson, and Perkins.

Where can scholarship be used? At any accredited two or four-year U.S. college or university.

- 5) A biographical sketch about yourself that may include such topics as your goals, interests, meaningful activities, career plans, why you should be considered for this scholarship, and how you plan to finance college education. (No more than 2 pages, double-spaced).
